Safety - Parking outside the main entrance has been set aside for buses, taxis and disabled only. Parents are not allowed to park in the staff car park. We ask for everyone's co-operation in this respect for the safety of the children. Please drive safely and slowly near the school and don't park in areas that block the flow of traffic.

The recent Estyn report recommended that the school needs to continue to work with the Local Authority to ensure the ease of flow of traffic by the school entrance at busy times of the day. Water in School – Pupils are invited to bring a plastic water bottle to school in order to use the school water fountain (please put your child's name on the bottle)

Care in the sun – We advise older pupils to bring sun cream to school and to wear a hat or appropriate clothing to reduce the risk of sun burn. Parents / guardians of younger pupils should apply sun cream before pupils come to school.
