Absenoldeb – os fydd eich plentyn yn absennol mae angen :

1. Cysylltu â'r ysgol i ddweud na fydd eich plentyn yn yr ysgol (galwad ffôn neu e-bost cyn 9.00)
2. Ysgrifennu nodyn i athro / athrawes eich plentyn yn nodi'r rheswm am yr absenoldeb (danfonwch y nodyn gyda'ch plentyn pan fydd yn dychwelyd i'r ysgol)

Dod â chacennau i'r ysgol

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Safety – *Parents and guardians (apart from Meithrin) are reminded to remain outside the fence / gate until pupils are released.*

Parking outside the main entrance has been set aside for buses, taxis and disabled only. Parents are not allowed to park in the staff car park. We ask for everyone's co-operation in this respect for the safety of the children.

Please drive safely and slowly near the school and don't park in areas that block the flow of traffic.

Walking, cycling, sharing a car or using the car park by the Mudiad Ysgolion Meithrin are ways of reducing traffic near the school. Our most recent Estyn report recommended that the school needs to continue to work with the local authority to ensure the ease of flow of traffic by the school entrance at busy times of the day. Your co-operation is needed with this matter.

Arriving at school on time – *as a school we have to keep a note of pupils who are continually arriving late to school. Please make every effort to ensure that your child arrives at school before 9 o'clock and is collected promptly at the end of the school day.*

Absent from school – *if your child is absent from school you need to:*

- 1. Inform the school before 9 o'clock that your child will be absent (telephone or e-mail)*
- 2. Write a note to your child's teacher explaining the reason for the absence (send the letter to school with your child when he / she returns to school)*

Bringing cakes to school

It has become a tradition by some families to bring cakes to school to share with other class members as part of birthday celebrations. We are aware that this is a friendly gesture but we kindly ask for this practise to come to an end. We have many pupils in school who have allergies towards a variety of foods. Food prepared at home can increase the risk for those individuals.
