Wrth annog ymddygiad cadarnhaol, mae gennym gamau mwy pendant i'w dilyn pan nad yw'r disgylion yn cydymffurfio gyda'r rheolau a'r disgwyliadau. 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### **A successful first week**

Thank you all for your cooperation this week. Seeing you walk with your children to their classes in the mornings and the excitement in the children's faces was wonderful! Next week we will return to the procedure of dropping off at the gate. The reason for this is to keep the site and the children as safe as possible. We understand that some of the youngest children, the Meithrin in particular, will find it difficult at the gate - at that point you are of course welcome to go to the door of the Meithrin. If your child is concerned about the mornings remember to communicate that with the teachers so that we can assist you.

### **Punctuality**

I would like to emphasise the importance of punctuality in the mornings please. A prompt start in the morning helps the children to follow a good pattern for the rest of the day. It can also reduce their anxiety, and ensure that they do not miss any important information or discussions at the start of the school day.

### **Encouraging positive behaviour and sharing messages**

Thank you for your responses to the questionnaire shared at the end of the year. Your contributions help us to continually improve the school. One aspect we have immediately addressed is the need for consistency and clarity with behaviour. When encouraging positive behaviour, we have more concrete steps to follow when the pupils do not comply with the rules and expectations. Stages 1 and 2 are verbal warnings from the staff reminding them positively of the rules, stage 3 is the loss of 5 minutes of playing time and a conversation with the Head of Stage (Miss Davies or Mrs Davies), then stage 4 is the loss of 10 minutes of playing time, a conversation with the Headteacher and contact with parents. We hope this will make it clear that the minor issues are dealt with, and that you as parents receive a phone call/email when more serious incidents occur. We will monitor the effectiveness of this during the term.

### **Swimming**

Swimming lessons will start for years 3, 4, 5 and 6 at the end of September. They will receive lessons every other week throughout the year. The timetable is noted on the Half Term Calendar.

### **Hockey – Year 6**

This year's hockey games will be held on Thursday evenings, between 4 and 5 o'clock on the new all-weather surface at Plascrug Leisure Centre. Priority will be given to year 6 players, with the intention of extending the invitation to year 5 if the need arises. They will be friendly games, between other schools in the Aberystwyth area. More information to follow.

### **Wow!**

We will continue to keep a register of the ways the pupils travel to school in the mornings. We encourage where possible, and safely, that you travel by walking, cycling or scooting. We also understand that many of you travel from a distance, and that the car is the only option. What we noticed last year was an increase in the number of pupils saying that they 'Park and Stride' - meaning that you make an effort to park further away from the school area, and then walk. Thank you very much for this.
